

2024 The 2nd Quzhou International Friendly Children Amateur Weiqi Invitational Tournament Regulation

4. Time and Venue

It will be held in Quzhou, Zhejiang Province from November 17, 2024 to November 22, 2024, at Quzhou Nankong Guantang Hotel

(Address: No. 8 Mazhandi, Fushan Street, Kecheng District, Quzhou)

5. Composition of each participating team

A total of 42 children amateur players from 14 teams around the world participated in the competition.

6. Qualification

1) The team consists of one team leader and three amateur players.

- 2) The players are aged between 7 and 18.

7. Competition Method

- 1) The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest rules enacted by the Chinese Weiqi Association.
- 2) All matches will be played in a rule of Weiqi to arrange the boards of players beforehand with 6-round Swiss system. Each team shall submit the order of the players (3 players per team, the first table is the captain) to the referee team at the time of registration, and shall not be changed after the start of the first round.
- 3) Time limit is 60 minutes for each side and three (3) time 30 seconds overtime period. and the dame still needs to be timed. If a player fails to make a move within time limits, he or she will be declared to have lost the game.
- 4) The scoring method of the game: two game scores will be awarded for a winning game, and zero for a lost game. Two round scores will be awarded to the team with higher game scores, zero for the team with lower game score. An unmatch team will be awarded two round scores and zero game score.
- 5) The team ranking will be defined in following order: Team' s round scores, Game scores, Opponent's total round scores, Direct result between two teams, Deduction of opponent's round scores from Round 1 on, compare the the optimal opponent, if it is still the same, draw lots to decide the ranking.
- 6) Table ranking calculation method: Compare the Game scores and the ranking of the team, players with higher team ranking rank higher.
- 7) Matters not mentioned for the competition will be announced.

8. Ranking and Awards

- 1) The top 6 teams will be awarded trophies, certificates of honor and bonuses (before tax). The first place is RMB 30,000, the second is RMB 20,000, the third is RMB 10,000, and the fourth to sixth places are RMB 5,000 each.
- 2) Ranking 7 to 10 teams will be awarded trophies and certificates of honor.
- 3) The top six players in each table will be awarded certificates of honor

9. Admission Information

- 1) Basic competition expenses (meals, accommodation, venue and materials, etc.) shall be borne by the organizer. Each team shall have 2 single rooms and 2 standard rooms.
- 2) The round-trip travel expenses of the team leaders will be borne by the organizing committee. The organizing committee will bear half of the travel expenses of three players, and the upper limit of the reimbursement shall not exceed RMB 5,000 (based on actual expenses). The mode of transportation is economy class on plane and second class on high-speed rail. Accompanying person shall bear their own expenses.
- 3) The team leader meeting shall be held before the competition, and the specific time shall be separately announced in the supplementary notice. All teams must have a team leader to attend the meeting.
- 4) All players are obliged to participate in the opening ceremony, award ceremony and other official activities required by the organizing committee.

**2024 The 2nd Quzhou International Child Friendly Amateur
Weiqi Invitational Tournament
Supplementary Regulations**

1. The tournament follows a six-round Swiss system; team numbers are publicly drawn, and the scheduling process is computer-assisted.
2. Refer to the event schedule for specific tournament dates.
3. Based on the pairing results, for teams listed on the left side of the match list, players on Table 1 and Table 3 play as black, while the player on Table 2 plays as white. For teams on the right side, players on Table 1 and Table 3 play as white, and the player on Table 2 plays as black.
4. In the event of a match where the outcome cannot be determined by the rules, the match is considered a draw. Both players immediately engage in a rematch, with the same overtime period as the original match, and the remaining time in the original match is carried over to the rematch.
5. If a dispute arises during a match, players must cease play and immediately report the same to the referee.
6. Disciplines
 - (1) Valid identification must be worn upon entering the venue.
 - (2) Closed-off management will be exercised at the venue (including the playing area and restrooms). Players are prohibited from bringing electronic devices such as phones and smartwatches into the playing area, the violation of which will result in a loss for that round.
 - (3) Players arriving more than 15 minutes late for a round (including the 15th minute) will

be considered forfeited. For players arriving late for less than 15 minutes, the late time will be doubled and deducted from the player's match time.

- (4) After a match, players are required to raise their hands to signal the end of the match to the referee, and the result confirmation sheet must be signed by both players.
- (5) Players are required to promptly leave the playing area after their match and refrain from discussing ongoing matches.
- (6) Team leaders, accompanying staff, and media are allowed to take photos (no flash) during the first 20 minutes of each round and must leave the playing area promptly after the designated time.
